Regulations

1. The tournament is sanctioned by and will be held under the law, rules and regulations of Tennis Ireland and the Tennis Ireland Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced and will be available in the Club House.
2. Enter online or download an Entry Form at www.naasltc.net One entry form per person. A maximum of three events may be entered.
3. Entries close at 12 midnight on Monday 23rd May 2016.
4. The draw will take place in the Clubhouse on Thursday 26th May 2016. Schedule of play will be available online on www.naasltc.net Thursday 26th from 10pm.
5. Play will commence on Sunday 29th May at 10am. Play will commence at 7pm Monday to Thursday and 6pm on Friday 3rd June 2016.
6. Finals will take place on Saturday 4th June 2016.
7. Competitors not present when called upon to play may be disqualified. It is the duty of the competitors to acquaint themselves of the times at which they are to play by checking the web daily.
8. All singles matches will be the best of three tie break sets.
9. All doubles events up to finals stage will have championship tie break in 3rd set. Finals will be best of three tie break sets.
10. All entrants should be available to play Sunday 29th May 2016 and finals day Saturday 4th June.
11. Entrants may indicate one evening during the week that they are unavailable to play.
12. Every effort will be made to accommodate players involved in summer league matches.
13. Entrants in Events 5-23 must be over 18 on 01 January 2016.
14. Recognised Tennis Attire must be worn.
15. The decision of the Referee or Deputy Referee is final in all matters relating to the Tournament.
16. No player can enter an event in a class below the class they played in Summer League in 2015/16.
17. The Committee reserve the right to exclude or to re-grade an entry of any player whose standard is considered to be above the Class of the event entered.
18. The Committee reserve the right not to hold an event if the number of entries is inadequate. The Tournament Committee, Club and sponsors shall not be held responsible for any injury, illness or accident on or off the court to any players or guest or for any property damaged, destroyed, lost or stolen.
