A Brief History



The County Kildare Club was founded on February 18th 1881. The name of the club was changed to Naas Lawn Tennis at the Annual General Meeting held on October 18th 1978. It was in 1906 that the lease to the club was signed (the current "Junior Club House" dates from the same year). From 1971 to date the club has progressed from 5 grass courts to 11 synthetic all weather courts. In 1993 the new clubhouse was built and in 2013 completely refurbished. In 2011 "the dome" was installed which covers 3 courts in winter. In 2015 the floodlights and fencing around the courts will be completely replaced. This continuous development program ensures the facility is always in excellent condition for you.

What's on offer for you as a member

We offer you an opportunity to play tennis both competitively and socially and are always looking to welcome new members. For the new tennis player looking for a social game we have "Social Tennis" every Friday at 8pm and Sunday Morning at 9.00am. This is a great opportunity to meet new members and enjoy a social game of tennis. With social tennis you get to meet players at your level and you can organize your own games from here if you wish. As your tennis starts to improve you can graduate into internal competitions which always have a section especially for beginners. Progressing from here you may want to get into a more serious competitive program. Here we offer you, all year round DLTC league tennis from Class 1 – 7, as well as club competitions organized at challenging and improving your standard.

The club runs a comprehensive coaching programme from beginner to international standard and you will be guided on a program suitable for you if you wish.
